The Kentucky Court of Justice listened to the suggestions by the Bar with respect to the complexity of the family law forms mandated by the FCRPP. In 2013, a FCRPP Forms Review Committee comprised of judges, agency representatives and practitioners was assembled and charged with the responsibility of reviewing all FCRPP-mandated forms in an effort to streamline and simplify the forms, including the simplification of the disclosure forms.

The proposed domestic relations forms are being piloted in collaboration with the KBA for your and the Bar's review, consideration and use prior to the Supreme Court Rules Hearing in June 2014. The pilot forms will be available to the Bar through the Kentucky Court of Justice website ([www.courts.ky.gov](http://www.courts.ky.gov)) in a fillable PDF format that can be saved to your computer.
