Environment	SB119	Carpenter	Chemical munitions: require reclassification of residual wastes after treatment or destruction to ensure proper management and disposal; details
Government	HB 290	Meeks	Omnibus no-excuse absentee voting bill: allow in-person voting for any reason in clerk's office or other approved location at least 12 days before an election
Health	HB 273	McKee	Require annual compilation of charges billed by air ambulance providers; make average but not individual provider cost subject to Open Records Act
Health	HB 282	Belcher	Prohibit health care providers from charging Medicare beneficiaries more than a reasonable charge for services as determined by HHHS
Health	HB 286	Flood	Abortion: allow private medical consultation required between pregnant woman and physician to occur through telehealth

Housing	HB 272	Thompson	Exempt residential building contractor installing vent pipes from radon mitigation certification requirements
Housing	HB 280	Meade	Require buyer to record deed of real estate sold by master commissioner within 5 days; allow master commissioner to obtain title to abandoned vehicles
Taxes	HB 275	Linder	Permit additional deduction up to \$250 for certain educators for expenses paid that would qualify for deduction except for federal limitation
