Education	<a href="#">HB 283</a>	Rollins	Provide that if a student has an IEP and the nature of a disability may necessitate school absences or tardiness, the student shall not be reported as truant
Education	<a href="#">HB 297</a>	Bratcher	Allow peace officer to release truant child to child's school; allow officer to detain child if school not in session
Education	<a href="#">HB 449</a>	Jenkins	Require Board of Ed to establish policies and guidelines for student assignment and data collection on alternative education programs
Education	<a href="#">HCR 15</a>	Rollins	Direct LRC to study the factors impacting the academic achievement of African-American male students in the public schools of the Commonwealth
Education	<a href="#">SB 160</a>	Palmer	Requiring district wide implementation of an aphasia, and related conditions, screening and response to intervention system in grades K-3

Family	<a href="#">HB 53</a>	Jenkins	Allow residents of other states not related to a decedent to be appointed as fiduciary if appointment is done pursuant to a will of the decedent
Family	<a href="#">HB 54</a>	Jenkins	Prohibit persons convicted of a felony under Chapter 209 from serving in any capacity that has authority over the victim of the offense or the victim's estate
Family	<a href="#">HB 72</a>	Crimm	Permit a court to provide for wage assignment and automatic electronic transfer of funds for payment of spousal maintenance
Family	<a href="#">HB 73</a>	Crimm	Allow child committed to custody of Commonwealth to request, within 12 months of becoming 18, to extend or reinstate the commitment; more

Family	<a href="#">HB 254</a>	Graham	Make orders of protection required training subject for law enforcement basic training and 2-year certified peace officers training
Family	<a href="#">HB 323</a>	Burch	Establish a preliminary license for licensed child-care centers and a preliminary certificate of operation for certified family child-care homes
Family	<a href="#">HB 342</a> *	Combs	Allow a bank or trust company of a another state to be appointed as fiduciary for matters of descent, will, and administration; provide for reciprocity; more
Family	<a href="#">HB 346</a>	Combs	Establish authority for CHFS to identify and take action against financial accounts of parents who fail to pay child support; set up data match system
Family	<a href="#">HB 441</a>	Burch	Establish a statewide child fatality and near fatality external review panel and set out its membership and duties

Family	<a href="#">HB 474</a>	Combs	Provide that attorney in fact, appointed under a power of attorney, shall not have the right to waive civil or constitutional rights or restrict the principal's freedom
Family	<a href="#">HB 493</a>	Tilley	Provide that if adverse party has been served with the summons, the hearing required within 14 days of issuance may be continued if the parties agree
Family	<a href="#">HCR 42</a>	Jenkins	Create Task Force on Children Exposed to and Affected by Domestic Violence; require report by 12-31-11
Family	<a href="#">SB 29</a>	Schickel	Provide for gender neutrality in the furnishing of necessities during marriage
Family	<a href="#">SB 49</a>	Harper Angel	Include persons in dating relationships within the coverage of Kentucky's domestic violence laws
Family	<a href="#">SB 105</a>	Denton	Require a child-care center to have a written plan for evacuation in the event of fire, natural disaster, or other threatening situation
Juvenile	<a href="#">HB 123</a>	Flood	Status offenders: require status offense complaints to include certain supporting documentation; restrict the secure detention of status offenders; more
