Community Education

Networking and Coalition Building

- Workers' Rights Task Force-Last meeting was August 10th. We had a full agenda: live streamed Kentucky Supreme Court oral arguments in right-to-work challenge and had discussions on the gig economy, 1115 waiver and other updates. Next meeting will probably be in between election and Thanksgiving or first part of December.
- Submitted comments on 1115 waiver, OSHA rollbacks and signed on to several other advocacy efforts at the federal level.

Litigation

- Working two co-counsel cases with Trent and his law firm against Louisville restaurants
 - Had opt-in notice published in Spanish newspaper pursuant to court decision.
 - Rescheduling depositions recently postponed
- Human trafficking civil case in Lexington still ongoing
