Case numbers:

- **154 cases** (116 immigration, 38 citizenship) since last board meeting
 - In the last year, we've handled **528 cases** (425 immigration, 103 citizenship)
- SIX U Visas approved that we've been working on since 2012
- SIX U Visa Law Enforcement Certifications signed (Lexington Police, Richmond Police, Madison Co. Attorney's Office, Judge Masterton, Judge Stein (2))
- 2 Special Immigrant Juvenile Status State Court Orders signed (Judge George, Judge Boyd)
