

## Maxwell Street Legal Clinic Board Report 04/21/2017

### Staff Changes

- Leah Engle started as new attorney/director for MSLC on 3/16/2017

### Caseload Summary

- Cases handled since 12/8/2016 board meeting: 107 with only one caseworker from 12/20/16 until 3/16/2017
- Cases in the last year: 687
- Averaging 475 calls a month with only one full time and one part time staff
- First Adjustment of status based on a T status filed, 1 principal, 3 derivatives

### Funding

- Client fees as of 4/15/2017 were \$8,530.00
- Donations since 11/30/2016: \$12,225

- KBF grant application submitted for emergency preparedness and special powers of attorney
