She, alongside other DACA youth, spoke on a panel following a film screening jointly hosted by Maxwell Street Legal Clinic and Kentuckians for the Commonwealth in August 2015. There were 50 people in the room. Nearly every single person was in tears. She also spoke about her experience as a young immigrant with attorney Guion Johnstone to a class at Transylvania University called "The Immigrant Child." Her story of overcoming adversity as a young

undocumented immigrant is extremely inspiring.
